On behalf of Space Florida, I am providing this report and certification of compliance concerning the Enhanced Biennial Review of our agency's rules as required by Sections 120.74 and 120.745, Florida Statutes, as follows:

- b. Clarify and simplify rules – No recommendations at this time.
- c. Delete obsolete and unnecessary rules – No recommendations at this time.
- d. Delete rules that are redundant of statutes – No recommendations at this time.
- e. Seek to improve efficiency, reduce paperwork, or decrease costs to government and the private sector - No recommendations at this time.
- f. Contact agencies that have concurrent or overlapping jurisdiction to determine whether their rules can be coordinated to promote efficiency, reduce paperwork, or decrease costs to government and the private sector – Space Florida does not have concurrent or overlapping jurisdiction with other agencies. Therefore, Space Florida has not contacted other agencies in this regard. Also, no other agency has contacted Space Florida to coordinate their rules with ours.
- g. Determine whether the rules should be continued without change or should be amended or repealed to reduce the impact on small business while meeting the stated objectives of the proposed rule – Space Florida rules do not have any disproportionate impact on small business. Space Florida is not involved in any cases or disputes and therefore has no recommendation as to the potential applicability of the summary hearing process in Section 120.574.
