The statute is self-effectuating.</p>

The amendment is intended to ensure the safety of the agency's personnel by protecting details of fire safety plans, which, if disclosed, could result in a security breach or other vulnerabilities that could compromise agency safety. All three statutes are self-effectuating.</p>
