119.12, F.S.	No.	N/A.	The statute requires the court to award a complainant reasonable costs, including attorneys' fees, when complainant files a civil enforcement action under the Public Records Chapter of the Florida Statutes and complies with certain notice provisions. The statute is self-effectuating.
255.0992, F.S.	No.	N/A.	The statute restricts any state or political subdivision that contracts for a public works project from imposing certain restrictive conditions on contractors, subcontractors, or suppliers. The statute is self-effectuating.
330.41, F.S.	No.	N/A.	A person who willfully or knowingly operates a drone that interferes with the premises or operations of a critical infrastructure facility commits a misdemeanor, however, federal, state, and other governmental agencies are exempt. A governmental entity seeking to limit drone operation near an infrastructure or similar facility must apply to the Federal Aviation Administration. The statute is self-effectuating.
